1. Angels- inspiration وَإِذْ يُوحَىٰ رَبُّكَ إِلَى الْمَلَائِكَةِ أَنِّي مَعَكُمْ

And when Allah inspired to the angels that I am with you

2. Inanimate objects- inspiration يَوْمَئِذٍ تَحْدُثُ أَخْبَارَهَا بَأَنَّ رَبَّكَ أَوْحَىٰ لَهَا

On that day she (earth) shall tell her news, because your lord had inspired her

3. Satan- temptation وَإِنَّ الشَّيَاطِينَ لَيُوحُونَ إِلَىٰ أَوْلِيَائِهِمْ لِيُجَادِلُوكُمْ
